- Plan activities and encourage participation in recreational activities

- Listen to, help problem-solve and refer clients to support networks or other resources
- Liaison and communication with individuals served, parents, family members and support networks

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide an engaging, activity-based environment for the children
- Administer medication when required
- Administer medical needs required
- Encourage participation in household activities and routines
- Carry out existing routines in the home: assist with homework and assignments, attend to chores and clean-up after activities, meal preparation and clean-up
- Complete daily documentation (including shift reports or shift slips, medication sheets, incident reports, contact notes)
- Maintain open communication through telephone contact and visits to the office
- Maintain awareness of and adherence to Agency policy and procedures

- Takes accountability to ensure all mandatory certifications and training are kept current

- Some post-secondary education in a related field an asset
