Criteria:

- Available to provide respite for the following dates:
June 23-July 5, July 20-23, July 31-Aug 3, August 13-18
- Able to provide assistance with tasks related to daily living, which may include:
 - Meal preparation, clean up and monitor for choking
 - Support, as needed, with mobility, such as walker and power scooter
 - Participate and engage in leisure activities such as board and card games
 - Community activities such as walks and swimming
 - Assist with Medication Administration, and lifts and transfers
- A valid class 5 driver's license

Experience/Training:

- Has current or is willing to complete training in Standard First Aid and other mandatory courses including: Nonviolent Crisis Intervention (CPI), and Medical Administration protocols
- Experience communicating with non-verbal people
- Experience supporting and handling an individual with behaviour
